

Registration Instructions for Herrinfesta Italiana Bocce Tournaments April 2, 2019

The **INTERNATIONAL TOURNAMENT** on Sunday, May 26, 2019 will contain two (2) divisions. The **Championship Division** is designed for teams that are experienced and competitive. The registration fee for the **Championship Division** is \$200.00 per team. The **Open Division** is designed for teams that are less experienced or occasional players. The registration fee for the **Open Division** is \$120.00 per team. Ball size for both **Championship** and **Open** tournaments is the standard 107 mm (4.25" diam) and the pallina is standard 50 mm (2" diam). ***An email address and cell phone number is required for the captain / contact person of the team.***

The **ADULT – CHILD TOURNAMENT** will be conducted on *Saturday, May 25, 2019*. Tournament play will begin at 12:30 pm. **The “children” members of the team must be at least 6 years of age and not yet 18 years of age. Adult team members will be individuals age 18 or older.** There must be at least one adult team member and there may be a maximum of two adults per team. ***Hitting will NOT be allowed in the ADULT-CHILD TOURNAMENT.*** A “youth size” ball will be used in this tournament. The ball size is 90 mm (3.54” diam) and the pallina is 41 mm (1.61” diam). The registration fee is \$60 per team. ***An email address and cell phone number is required for the captain / contact person of the team.***

Your submission of a registration implies that you have read the **CODE OF CONDUCT and the RULES** which are posted on the Bocce Registration section of this website. Unless all participants can adhere to this published **CODE OF CONDUCT and RULES (and play with the smaller than regulation size ball in the Adult – Child Tournament)** – please do not enter a team.

Registration for the HerrinFesta Italiana Bocce Tournaments are done electronically on this website and payment is to be made via credit card upon registering a team. Registration is NOT complete without payment.

The list of teams entered in each tournament will be updated and posted on the *HerrinFesta Italiana* website at www.herrinfesta.com. Also, once the tournament field is full – the brackets along with the time your team will play will also be posted on the website.
