## Herrinfesta Italiana Bocce

## **CODE OF CONDUCT**

- Bocce was included as part of Herrinfesta Italiana to allow this ethnic sport to have
  exposure and to grow in popularity. While recognizing that the "thrill of competition"
  and the "agony of defeat" evoke human emotions the Herrinfesta Italiana Bocce
  Committee intends that the tournament games remain first and foremost a means of
  entertainment for both the participants and spectators.
- The Herrinfesta Italiana Bocce Committee provides individuals to act as judges in order to facilitate tournament play and provide interpretation of tournament rules as adapted from the World Bocce Association. The Herrinfesta Italiana Bocce Committee prefers that team Captains assist Judges on all measurements; scorekeeping and the signing of the official scorecard following the game. Team members, other than Captains, should remain at the end of the court during measurements.
- Communication of game rules and of the Herrinfesta Italiana Bocce CODE OF CONDUCT to team members is the responsibility of the team Captain.
- Profanity, lewd conduct and public drunkenness will not be tolerated.
- Only the player whose turn it is to take a shot is allowed on the court. All other players on each team must be off the court.
- Team Captains, sometimes, may not be able to agree on the measurement and the judge, provided by *Herrinfesta Italiana*, is asked to decide the outcome. When this occurs the decision of THAT TOURNAMENT JUDGE is final.
- All Judges are volunteers and are present to assist in the tournament running smoothly. Abusive language aimed at or threats to volunteers, provided by the *Herrinfesta Italiana Bocce Committee*, will not be tolerated.
- Eligibility rules of the ADULT/CHILD TOURNAMENT have been established to
  facilitate play and to provide fairness. All participants entering the ADULT/CHILD
  TOURNAMENT must be able to provide proof of age through a birth certificate;
  baptismal certificate; driver's license or other legal document if asked at the time of the
  tournament.
- Herrinfesta Italiana Bocce Tournaments are conducted on property owned by the City of
  Herrin. As such, the sale, possession and consumption of ALL beverages is governed by
  the same rules of Herrinfesta Italiana. More specifically, no one under the age of 21
  shall consume alcoholic beverages; only beverages (both alcoholic and non-alcoholic)
  sold by Herrinfesta Italiana and served in containers provided by Herrinfesta Italiana
  may be consumed on the tournament grounds.
